- (e) For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co–Supervisor. Supervisor and Co–Supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.
- (f) *For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of (5b) Policy Document and (6) Invited Lectures/Resource Person/Paper Presentation shall have an upper capping of 30% of the total research score of the teacher concerned.
- (g) The Research Score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories of academic and research activities.
